

## Parent Code of Conduct

1. I will support my child, our Illinois United (ILS) teams, and coaches in a Christ-like way.
2. I will observe principles of good sportsmanship and fair play serving as a Christian role model for our children.
3. I will respect the officials' decisions.
4. I recognize my child's attendance in school is mandatory prior to any game, practice, and tournament unless special circumstances are brought to coach and/or athletic director.
5. I acknowledge that ILS athletics is a priority for my child. However, if an ILS practice is skipped to attend a non-ILS game or practice during a given week, playing time at that week's ILS game will be limited. If more than one practice is skipped during a given week, playing time will be sharply limited.
6. I recognize that if my child has two (2) Ds or one (1) F at mid-quarter and/or quarter breaks he or she will be ineligible. Upon being declared ineligible, my child's grades will be reassessed after a seven (7) day period to meet the minimum requirement to be declared eligible again. In the event of ineligibility, my child will still participate at practice. Additionally, my child will also attend games in uniform and be required to sit the bench with their team.
7. I realize verbally criticizing and arguing with officials, opposing teams, or their fans will not be tolerated and may be subjected to my ejection from an event, game, or contest.
8. I recognize coaches, the principal, or athletic directors reserve the right to withhold players from practicing and playing for inappropriate behavior.
9. I agree to withhold opinions and stances of the coach and his or her decisions for a 24 hour period before contacting the coach and/or athletic director about the coach's decisions.
10. I will inform friends, family members, and other spectators of ILS to respect coaches and officials' decisions and refrain from public negative criticism.
